

May the Fourth (be with you)



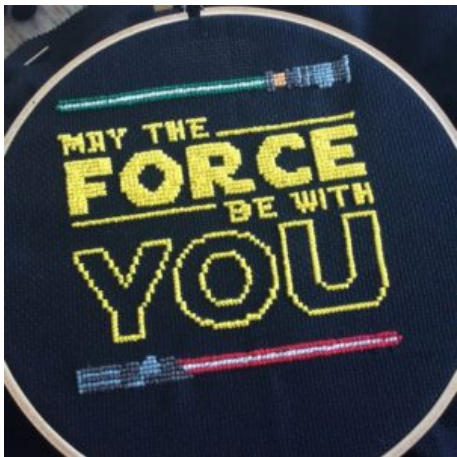
May the Fourth (be with you)...Happy Star Wars Day!

Love this awesome cut-out shirt resembling a storm trooper!



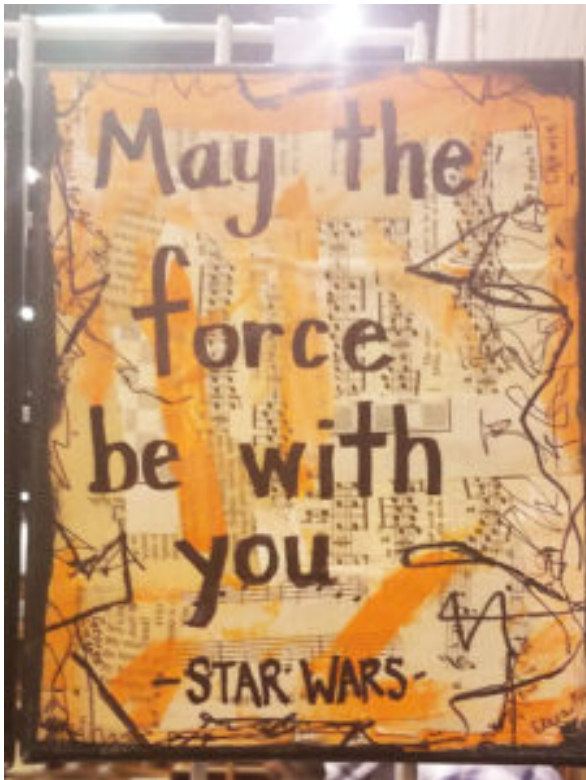
